SEATTLE GROUP BUYS TV TIME TO URGE AN END TO THE NUCLEAR ARMS RACE

In a landmark effort to stop the nuclear arms race, a Seattle organization, Legs Against Arms, has purchased \$23,500 worth of TV time to show two commercials urging people to write the new Congress to stop production of nuclear weapons.

This is the first time an all-volunteer organization has raised money to fight nuclear proliferation with a media campaign.

Legs Against Arms was formed in the Spring of 1982 for the sole purpose of organizing this campaign. Funds were raised by a 10K fun run on October 2, 1982. 1200 Participating runners pledged from \$5 to \$1,000 each. In addition, contributions of \$9,000 have been received from two anonymous donors.

Following the race, members of the Seattle advertising community were asked to submit proposals for TV commercials. Two were chosen: "Powerful Weapon", written and produced by Steve Sandoz of John Brown & Partners; and "History of War", written and produced by Bruce Howard, Jack Higgins and Greg Erickson.

Both commercials urge viewers to write their representatives in Congress and tell them to stop funding the U.S. production of
